12 Elements of a Jewish wedding

- 1. Parents chose a bride: (Eph 1:4)
- 2. Groom asks for the hand in marriage: (Jn 7:38)(Jn 3:16)
- 3. Groom pays the Bride price. (Eph 5:2)(Heb 10:10)
- 4. They drink together from one cup: (1 Cor 10:16)
- 5. Bride & Groom don't live together: (Jn 14:28)
- 6. Groom builds on to his father's house: (Jn 14:1-3)
- 7. Father decides when he can go get his bride (Mat 25:12)
- 8. Bride also prepares. (1 Cor 15:58)
- 9. Groom returns for the Bride: (1 Thes 4:16-17)
- 10. The bride goes out to meet the bridegroom.
- 11. The procession goes back to the groom's father's house.
- 12. Everyone goes to a reception & party: (Rev 19:9)

I. The Worship In Heaven: (Vs 1-6)

- a) The wedding music will be the Alleluia Chorus.
 - i) "Alleluia" is used four times in these six verses.
 "Alleluia" we are saying "Praise the Lord."
 - ii) "Amen" used in Revelation 19.
 - (1) "Amen" means "let it be." "So be It"

b) Stanza one is the redemption of the saints: (Rev 19:1)

- i) They sing 'Alleluia': what began at Calvary is now come to full consummation. (Philippians 1:6)
- c) <u>Stanza two is the retribution of the sinner</u>: (Rev 19:2) God avenges the persecuted of all the ages. (Rev 6:10) They sing "Hallelujah" for... Victory over Sin, Satan, Antichrist, False Prophet.

- **d)** Stanza 3 is the relationship of the saved: (Rev 19:4-5) He is our God: (Psalm 23:1)
- e) <u>Stanza four is the reign of the Savior</u>: (Rev 19:6) Every knee shall bow: (Rom 14:11-12)

II. The Wife in Heaven: (Vs 7-8)

The bride is the true church of the Lord Jesus Christ. (Is 54:5-6) (Jer 3:14)

We Are Betrothed to Christ: (2 Cor11:2)

The Holy Spirit is calling out a bride now: (Eph 5:25-27) (Rev 19:7-8) (Rev 21:9-10)

III. The Word/Invitation in Heaven: (Vs 9-10)

- a) There will be guests at the wedding other than the bride.
 - i) John 3:29
 - ii) Matthew11:11

THE GROOM WILL BE GLORIFIED (Revelation 19:10) (Heb 1:14)

<u>The Spirit of Prophecy</u>: is Jesus Christ.

"for the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy."

Both thoughts are closely related. (Eph 3:9-10) (1 Pet 1:10-12) (1 Cor 2:14)

The wedding is not far off: (Matt 25:6)
