# <u>3 Classic Examples of Temptation's Attraction:</u>

Explain Eve, Achan, David

We are tempted through our senses: (1 Jn 2:15-17) These 3 These Three Things Trump the Authority of the God's Word: Lust of the Eyes, Flesh, Pride of Life!

#### **Temptation's Deception**:

(Jam 1:16) *Do not err, my beloved brethren.* (James 1:14) *enticed.* = <u>*LURED!*</u> (Eph 6:13)

**Temptation's Preoccupation:** (James 1:14) *drawn away* King David is a good example of this: (2 Sam 11:1)

#### **Temptation's Conception**:

(James 1:15) *when lust hath conceived,* <u>**Temptation's Subjection**</u>: (James 1:15) *it bringeth forth sin:* 

#### King David is a good example of this: (2 Sam 11:1)

He had lost sight of his victory was in his relationship with God, not his Army. Drawn away from our Walk with God. Drawn away from work. Drawn away from Worshipping God. To Avoid being Drawn Away, Be Faithful in your Walk with God! Be Faithful in your Worship of God! Be Faithful in your Work for God!

#### **Drawn Away From What: Faithfulness to God!!** (Eph 2:10)

(Gal 5:16) Walking in the Spirit.

James gives 3 warnings: (James 1:14-18) "Learn ourselves and the temptation cycle" "Become convinced of the unswerving goodness of God" "Be aware of the significance of the New Birth."

In any relationship there are expectations: (Gal 5:16) Now that you are saved its still Not about DOING. Its about who are we Becoming in Christ: (Rom 8:28-29)

## Die to Self & Be Filled with the Spirit:

- 2. Pray: (Lk 18:1)(Matt 7:7-8) Ask, & it shall be given unto
- 3. Church: Attend and Serve: (Heb 11:24-25)
- **4. Tithe:** (Mal 3:8-12, 10\*) (1 Cor 16:2)
- 5. Witness: (Acts 1:8)(1 Pet 3:15) (2 Tim 2:15) Study

Moment by Moment course correction with God. (1 Jn 1:9) Are we growing to Become like Christ? (2 Pet 3:18) Growing in Christ is a life long process: (2 Pet 1:5-8)
