In order to become a more faithful witness we must understand

I) Who JESUS Is

John 1:1-5

A) Jesus is GOD John 1.1-2

Logos=the Word of God, or principle of divine reason and creative order, identified in the Gospel of John with the second person of the Trinity incarnate in Jesus Christ.

Plato the Greek philosopher said of the Logos everything started as a thought.

Philo the Hebrew philosopher took it a step further saying of the Logos everything started as a thought yes, but every thought has a thinker.

The Holy Spirit is saying that Jesus is the Logos the Word not only the Thinker, and Creator, but also the explainer.
