I. <u>Wisdom is Slow to Speak</u>: (Vs 1-12)

A. We are not to Arrogantly Reprove Others: (Vs 1-4)

- (Matt 7:2)(Mk 4:24) Measure Ye Mete
- Vs 1 People are watching and Listening
- Vs 2 We all offend in Many Ways/Many Times
- Vs 3 We have learned to tame animals
- Vs 4 We control large things with small things

B. Powerful Instrument of good or Evil: (Vs 5-12)

- (Job 21:5) "lay your hand upon your mouth."
- Vs 5 It seems so small an insignificant!
- Vs 6 Our Tongue is small; Can destroy our world.
- Vs 7-8 We can seem to train Mindless Brutes with ease.
- Vs 9-10 The Duality of our Speech Behavior
- Vs 11-12 <u>Nature is Definitive</u>. (Matt 12:37) Our words will Confirm/our testimony!

II. Wisdom from Below: (Vs 13-16)

Vs 13 You are a Teacher of others who watch you. Out of our Mouthes: (Matt 15:18-20) (Prov 22:24-25) "Meekness & Wisdom" (Lk 6:43-49) Vs 14 Who is the Liar of vs 14? Vs 15 Our Flesh is Devil-like. Vs 16 The Contradictory nature of our mouth

III. Wisdom from Above: (Vs 17-18)

Vs 17 What is the key to keeping our tongues under control?Vs 18 What comes out our mouths is the fruit sown there."Sown in Peace" - Quiet times with God: (Gal 6:6-10)

The purpose of God for our tongue

A. To confess Christ: (Romans 10:8-9, Matthew 10:32)

- B. To witness for Christ: (Revelation 12:11)
- C To bless God and man: (Psalm 19:14)

EXERCISES FOR YOUR TONGUE

(James 1:26) Here are 13 of them, based on <u>James chapter 1</u>.

1. <u>Tell your tongue to be joyful</u>. (vs. 2) "Praise the Lord! He's still working on me".

- 2. <u>Tell your tongue to speak patiently</u>. (vs. 3,4) "My goal is to give them all they need for their maturity"
- 3. <u>Tell your tongue to pray for wisdom</u>. (vs.5) "I need wisdom".
- 4. <u>Remind your tongue to ask in faith</u>. (vs. 6-8) *"I trust God is working all things together for good"* (Rom 8:28).
- 5. <u>Remind your tongue to ask in hope</u>. (vs. 9-11) "God promises that there are better things to come"
- 6. <u>Tell your tongue to rejoice & pray for endurance</u>:(v12) "With God's help I'm not giving up".
- 7. <u>Tell your tongue to be thankful</u>. (vs. 12) "Thank you God for giving me rewards".
- 8. <u>**Tell your tongue to be loving**</u>. (vs. 12) *"I love you Heavenly Father"*.
- 9. <u>Tell your tongue to stop complaining</u>. (vs. 13-15) "Everything God does is good. I'm the sinner, I am the one that gets drawn away, not Him!"
- 10.<u>Tell your tongue not to be deceived</u>. (vs. 16-18) "I can count on God to be good to me at all times"
- 11. Tell your tongue to be quiet. (vs. 19-20)

"Be slow to speak, so that my Ears will be able to be swift to Hear, & so that my Flesh will be slow to Wrath".

12. Tell your tongue to speak clean words. (vs. 21)

"I want my tongue to be clean, because I'm getting ready to use it to speak the Word of God". Use soap on you if necessary.

It is also good to RECITE (1 John 1:6-9). "Thank you God for forgiving me."

13. <u>Tell your tongue to change gears</u>. (vs. 21-27)

"Now let's practice what you preach. It's time for my feet to exercise what my tongue has been saying".

God wants us to give others something that is pure: (vs. 27)
