- **4. To Our Family** *Illus: Blood is thicker than water!*

- **a. Siblings:** Solomon wrote this verse having been raised in a home with Strife among siblings. Amnon, Abselom, Tamar.
- **b.** Can someone abuse your sibling and you stand idly by? Then they don't have your heart.

5. To Our Church -Is Church an Optional accessory in your life? (Heb 10:24-25)

Children learn our habits and Values What kind of church member are you?

<u>Illus</u>: If you think if you don't like it or don't get your way you can just leave here and go down the road, then **You haven't given your heart to** it.

- a. If you think your faithfulness doesn't matter, then you haven't given your heart to it.
- b. If you figure someone else will take care of it, you haven't given it your heart
- c. If you don't see Sunday's results as your personal responsibility too? # of visitors, # Saved, # baptized. Then you haven't given your heart to it.
- d. How long would the church exist if everyone Tithed like you do?
- e. How Long would the church exist if everyone was as faithful as you?
- f. What kind of shape would the property be in if everyone was as diligent to maintain it as you are? **Have you given your heart to it.**
- **6. To Our Pastor** Heb 13:17;
 - **a.** I don't try and run your life, but is stands to reason that God may give me a message for you. 1 Tim 5:17 *Double Honour!*
 - **b.** If the Preacher advises against it, LISTEN: Otherwise, stop complaining!

- c. I was a Lay men, I still work a job, Married, have kids, run finances, bought homes, cars, use computers, and serve the Lord faithfully in every aspect of this church.
