<u>Series</u>: One Confused Parent to Another <u>Title</u>: Where do I set the Boundaries? <u>Text</u>: (Galatians 5:19-25)

1. If God's against it, so am I.

Do you believe He Love's you? (Jn 15:13; 1 Jn 3:16; 1 Jn 4:9-10) Do you believe He wants the Best for you? (Is 55:8-13; Jn 10:10) Do you believe He knows What's Best? (Rom 8:28* Key to living free) He knows you! (Psalm 139:1-6) He knew what we would look like! (Psalm 139:15-16)

(Ps 139:2) He knows what I have done and will do!

(Ps 139:3) He knows where I go and how I live.

(Job 23:10) *He knoweth the way that I take* (Job 31:4) *Doth not he see my ways, and count all my steps?*

(Ps 139:4) He knows what I say. (Matt 12:36)

(Ps 139:5) He knows what I feel. (Heb 4:15)

He knows all this about me, yet he loves me anyway! (Jer 31:3)

He knew what a sinner I would become, yet he loved me inspite of it! (1 Jn 4:10) (Rom 5:8)

God's Plan for Salvation is Best: (Eph1:5) (Rom 8:29)

1. <u>Decide now, God is always Right!</u> *"If God is AGAINST it, then so am I." "If God is FOR it, Then So Am I."*

2. Determine to learn what "Right" is & Do It: (2 Pet 1:5)

<u>How to Apply Principles, Convictions, Standards to our daily life</u>: A *Principle* is a Bible truth I must live by. A *Conviction* is a personal belief based on a *Bible Principle*. A *Standard* is a guideline that helps me keep my *Convictions*. *Websters* ~ That which is established as a rule or mode

Do you know how to read?(Eph 3:1-6; Col 4:16)Do you know how to ask?(1 Jn 5:14; Jn 15:7-8)Do you know how to listen?(James 1:19)

- 2. Determine to learn what "Right" is and Do It:
- 3. **Detour to stay right!** What part of this World are you in control of?

<u>I will turn over control to the Holy Spirit</u>: – (Ps 101) Our children will not become what we tell them. Our children Become what we are.

- (Vs 1) I can yield control of what comes out of my mouth.
- (Vs 2) I can yield control of how I act.
- (Vs 3) I can yield control of what goes in my Eyes.
- (Vs 4) I can yield control of my Appetites. I can yield control of who I RUN with.
- (Vs 5) I can yield control of what goes in my EARS.
- (Vs 6 I) can yield control of who I associate with and Choose friends with Character!
- (Vs 7) I can yield control of those God has placed under my authority.

The question is: Will We choose to yield control of ourself to the Holy Spirit?
