<u>Title</u>: King Saul <u>Text</u>: (Acts 13:21)

The Life of Samuel was a transitional period in Israel. Time of the Judges to their First King.

I. The Request for a King: (1 Sam 8:4-22) Samuel's sons were Sinful (Vs 1-5) Israel forgot Jehovah was really their King: (Vs 6-10) God warned them about having a man as king: (Vs 11-18)

**Reasons: for Wanting a King**: (Vs 20-22) (Vs 20) "that our king may judge us," (Vs 20) "go out before us, and fight our battles."

II. The Selection of Saul: (1 Sam 9:1-27) (Vs 1-2) Looked Like a Head & Shoulders Taller (Vs 15-17) Chosen by God:

III. The Coronation of Saul: (1 Sam 10:1-27) (Vs 22) Saul was fearful.

IV. <u>The Reign of Saul</u>: (1 Sam 11-12) (vs 5) Unify the nation.

The Ark was returned, but not to the Tabernacle.
Inter-Tribal Warfare: Destabilized Israel
(Eph 4:32) Its a Command, not a suggestion.
(Rom 14:4) They will answer to God, not you.
(Rom 12:14, 17, 19-21) You expect me to let God handle it.
(Prov 24:17-18, 29) Do Not Rejoice when God judges.

(Prov 25:21-22) OT Sermon on the Mount. (Mat 5:39-41; 43-48) Yeah, God meant that. (Mk 11:25-26) Forgive, or god will hold it against you!

## V. The Rejection of Saul: (1 Sam 13-15)

(1 Sam 13:1-4) Saul was Ego Driven:

(1 Sam 13:5-8) Saul struggled with the Fear of Man. (\*11) (Prov 29:25)

(1 Sam 13:9-10) Saul took matters in his own hands:

(1 Sam 13:11-14) Samuel Arrives on time:

(1 Sam 15:1-14) Saul chose the praise of men (Vs 1-3) God commands Saul to Destry the Amalekites. (Vs 7-9) Saul's Partial Obedience (Vs 13-15) Saul blames the people. (Vs 16-23) Saul is rejected.

(Vs 24) *Ihave sinned:* - Samuel was not impressed (Vs 25-26) Disobedience is Rejection of God's Word.

(Vs 30-31) Saul was more concerned for his reputation (1 Sam 16:14) An evil spirit troubled Saul.
