### Title: Elijah & Elisha: Big Prayers to a Big God

- I. Elisha would not be discouraged! (2 Kings 2:1-14)
  - a. Vs 2 Elijah repeatedly asked him to tarry behind.
    - i. "Stop now, what a waste of time.
    - ii. You have all the blessings you need.
  - b. Vs 3, 5, 7 The "Brethren" Tried to discourage him.
  - c. Vs 8-9 The Blessing came on the Other Side: Pray Through!

## II. Elisha saw Miracles of Elijah, Knew it was God Possible Elijah's Miracles

- a. Elijah Fed by Ravens: (1 Kings 17:1-6)
- b. Widows Meal & Oil Replenished Daily: (1 Kings 17:8-16)
- c. Elijah Raises the Widows Son: (1 Kings 17:17-23)
- d. Fire consumes the offering: (1 Kings 18-36-38)
- e. Fed by an angel: (1 Kings 19:5-7)
- f. Calls down fire to consume captain & 50 men: (2 Ki 1:9-12)
- g. Divides the waters of Jordan (2 Kings 2:8)
- h. Elijah goes to Heaven in a Whirlwind (2 Kings 2:11)

#### Elisha's Miracles

- i. Parts the Waters of the Jordan (1 Kings 2:14)
- j. Heals the water with Salt (2 Kings 2:21-22)
- k. Curses 42 children & are attacked by bears (2 Kings 2:23-25)
- 1. Country filled with water (2 Kings 3:16-20)
- m. Increase of Widow's Oil (2 Kings4:1-7)
- n. Birth of son to Barren Shunamite woman (2 Kings 4:8-17)
- o. Resurrection of the Shunamite Woman's Son (2 Ki 4:18-37)
- p. Heals noxious pottage (2 Kings 4:38-41)
- q. Feeds 100 men with 20 Loaves (2 Kings 4:42-44)
- r. Naaman's Leprosy Healed (2 Kings 5:1-19)
- s. Commands Leprosy on his servant (2 Kings 5:20-27)
- t. Makes the lost axehead to swim (2 Kings 6:5-7)
- u. Opens his servant's eye to see the host of Fire (2 Ki 6:13-17)
- v. Blinds the Syrian Army (2 Kings 6:18-20)
- w. God scatters the Syrian Army: (2 Kings 7:1-16)
- x. Man resurrected by touching Elisha's bones: (2 Ki 13:20-21)

# (2 Kings 2:9) Elijah was not insulted by this, but rather delighted that Israel had not been left without a Faith Filled Prophet! God was not Insulted, but delighted in being Believed.

### **God wants us to Pray BIG Prayers**

- 1. (Ps 81:10) Shows His credentials of the 10 Plagues & Red Sea.
  - a. (Mal 3:6) Still the Same God!
  - b. (James 4:2) We have little because we ask Little.
- 2. (Jer 32:27) Behold, I am the LORD, the God of all flesh: is there any thing too hard for me?
- 3. He wants to convince us of His ability! (Jer 33:3) Call unto me & I will answer thee& shew thee great& mighty things which thou knowest not
- 4. Ask Big Things: (Matt 17:20) If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; & it shall remove; & nothing shall be impossible unto you.
- 5. <u>Believe BIG Things</u>: (Mk 9:23) *Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.* ("All Things")
- 6. (Matt 21:21-22)
- 7. (Eph 3:20-21) Greater than our Imaginations!

### III. Big Prayers Glorify God by displaying His Great Power!

(1 Ki 18:38-39) Then the fire of the LORD fell & consumed the burnt sacrifice & the wood & the stones & the dust & licked up the water that was in the trench. & when all the people saw it, they fell on their faces & they said, The LORD, he is the God; the LORD, he is the God

### IV. Big Prayers Prosper God's Work! (John 14:12-14)

- a. ANYTHING MEANS ANYTHING!!!!
- **b.** Anything means reaching into the Supernatural for a miracle!
- c. (Mark 16:15-18) Definitely Involves Miracles
  - i. Vs 17 Not just the Apostles, but all believers!
