Title: The Unexpected Jesus Text: (Luke 7:36-50)

What made Him Unexpected?

<u>They Knew When He would be Born</u>: (Dan 9:25-26) <u>They Knew Where He would be Born</u>: (Micah 5:2) <u>Herod wasn't Expecting Him, but the Wise Men were</u>: (Matt 2:1-2) <u>Herod likes things the way they were</u>: (Matt 2:16-17) Slaughtered the children of Bethlehem. <u>He Didn't Speak the Way They Expected</u>: (Jn 7:46) <u>He Didn't Act the Way They Expected</u>: (Mk 1:40-41)

BUT: When they encountered Jesus, they were never the Same.

Mary & Joseph; The Shepherds; The Wisemen; Simeon & Anna:

Some Experienced Jesus Unintentionally & were never the Same:

The 12 Disciples were sought out by Jesus. The Cripple at the Pool of Bethesda: (Jn 5:1-9) The Man Born Blind: (Jn 9:1-7)

The Widows Dead Son: (Lk 7:11-17)

Some Sought Out Jesus Intentionally & were never the Same:

Nicodemus: The Religious: (Jn 3) The Woman with an Issue of Blood: (Matt 9:20-22)

The Centurion: (Lk 7:1-10)

The Self-Righteous & The Sinful Women: (Lk 7:36-50)

I. <u>The Invitation</u>: (Vs 36) <u>The Invitation was Unusual</u> - The Pharisees hated Christ. <u>The Invitation was Uncordial</u> - The Pharisee neglected all the common Courtesies of the Eastern Culture. (Vs 44-46)

II. <u>The Intrusion</u>: (Vs 37) <u>First - She Washed His Feet.</u> "and began to wash his feet with tears,"

Second - She wiped His Feet with Her Hair: (1 Cor 11:15) "and did wipe *them* with the hairs of her head,"

Third - She Kissed His Feet.

Fourth - She Anointed His Feet: (2 Sam 24:24)

III. <u>The Indignation</u>: (VS 39)
