Title: How to Make Heaven Rejoice!

Text: (Lk 15:1-32)

(Vs 1-2) Completely oblivious of the Father's Love!

(Vs 3-6) <u>Illus</u>: You ever lose a sheep?

(Vs 7) Completely oblivious of Heaven's Joy!

(Vs 8-9) Loss of Something Precious!

(Vs 10) Completely oblivious of Heaven's Joy!

(Vs 11-12) Presumptuous to ask, Dad isn't dead Yet

This was not the will of the Father.

(Prov 15:5) *A fool despiseth his father's instruction:*

A Fool cannot be reasoned with! (Prov 12:15)

The Smartest thing the father did, was let him go!

(Vs 13-14a) "And when he had spent all" You will spend All

(Vs 14b) Life never goes the way you think. (Prov 5:8-11; Prov 6:26)

(Vs 15) Sin will lead you to do things you wouldn't normally find yourself doing. (Swine=Abomination)

(Vs 16) Hunger brings our Pride down. (James 4:6)

(Vs 17) Jr. Finally Hits Bottom & was fortunate to be alive!

(Vs 18-19) Jr. Realized his BETRAYAL! (Prov 11:2) shame:

(Vs 20a & 21) *Repentance!* - (1 John 1:9)

(Vs 20b) Oblivious to how much the Father loved him

(Vs 22-24) We See Heaven's Joy! - (Luke 15:7,10)

(Vs 25-28) The Elder Brother is a picture of the Pharisees

I. Attitude of Unforgiveness: Lk 15:28-30

A. Self Righteous: VS 29 Look at me, I serve, I Obey,

B. Self Deceived: (Matt 7:3-4)

1. We Compare ourselves to others: (2 Cor 10:12)

Avoid human comparisons: Vs 29a "I served" (1 Pet 2:21) We are not the standard, Jesus is!

Resist exaggerations to make ourself look good: Vs 29b

That's a Lie—Don't think too highly of yourself! Rom 3:23!

(2 Cor 10:12) We Are Un Wise! (James 4:10)

C. <u>Self Centered</u>: He felt Cheated. Vs 29c yet thou never 1. <u>He had a Pity Party</u>: (Gal 6:7-9) What, More, Later.

D. <u>Selfish</u>: Greedy *Vs 29d "Never gavest me a kid"* (Vs 12) *And he divided unto them his living* (Vs 31) *All that I have is thine!* (Matt 20:10-15) Working for a penny a day.

1. The World Owes Me:

2 <u>I have rights</u>: (Pro 6:27-28) You cannot Sin & Win

II. No Joy for his brothers B/c he had no forgiveness:

A. <u>Don't forget where you came from</u>: (Ps 40:2) (Lk 15:17-19) *Didn't just think about it,*

- **1. <u>Recognize our own sin</u>:** (Is 64:6; Rom 3:10, 3:23)
- 2. Accept Forgiveness: (Eph 1:7) He will forgive you
- **3. Forgive and be forgiven:** (Matt 6:14-15; 18:32-35)

B. Maybe you cannot forgive others:

(Ps 103:14) (Mic 7:19)

III. <u>He could not forgive, because He didn't realize how precious his brother is to the Father!</u>

(Vs 30) "Thy Son" he blamed the Father for this.

A. Maybe you don't think you can be forgiven:

You have forgotten how precious you are to the Savior!

- 1. You have never met my Jesus! (Heb 7:25)
- **2.** God's Love is not dependent upon your behavior: (Jer 31:3; Deut 7:7-8)
- **3.** Lk 23:34 The Roman Soldiers could be forgiven, SO CAN YOU! (1Tim1:15) *Chief of Sinners*

You are Precious to Jesus! You are the reason He came! LK 19:10! Rom 5:8 Jesus was motivated to action & sacrifice!

Let us be like the FATHER rather than the OLDER BROTHER!
