<u>Title</u>: Being the Evidence of the Gospel

Text: Joshua chapter 2

1. Rahab forsook her former life: (Vs 1-2)

- A. The wise strategy of Joshua: (Vs 1)
 - 1. The spies entered Rahab's house (Vs 1)
 - 2. The spies were spotted & the king informed: (Vs 2)
- B. The Courageous Decision of Rahab: (Vs 3-6)
 - 1. The king ordered Rahab to turn over the spies: (Vs 3)
 - 2. The first sign of Rahab's faith in God
 - She hid the spies: (Vs 6)
 - She admitted they came, but denied knowing: Vs 4
 - She stated that they had left: (Vs 5a)
 - She suggested they pursue quickly: (Vs 5b)
 - She had hid them on her roof
 - 3. The Hot Pursuit of the Kings Patrol: (Vs 7)

II. Rahab believed the testimony about God: (Vs 8-11)

- A. Her Strong Conviction:
 - 1. The LORD gave Israel land: (Vs 9)
 - 2. The LORD delivered Israel from Egyptian slavery
 - 3. The LORD dried up the Red Sea: (vs 10a)
 - 4. The LORD gave victory over Sihon & Og: (Vs 10b)
 - 5. The result: A spirit of fear gripped them: (Vs 11a)
- B. Her Strong Confession: The LORD is God: (Vs 11b)

III. Rahab Requested Salvation: (Vs 12-16)

A picture of calling upon the LORD (Ro.10:13)

- A. Asked for a guarantee of safety: (Vs 12)
- B. The Strong Expression of Her Faith: (Vs 13)
- C. The Strong Oath of the Spies: (Vs 14)

- 1. Pledged their word & their lives
- D. The Strong Demonstration of Her Faith: (Vs 15-16)
 - 1. She helped the spies escape: (Vs 15)
 - 2. She advised the spies where to find refuge: (Vs 16)

IV. Rahab's 3 Conditions for Salvation: (Vs 17-21)

- A. The Conditions of her Salvation:
 - 1. She must tie the scarlet rope in the window: (Vs 18) Identify her's as a "house of safety"
 Pictures of the blood of Christ, the Passover Lamb
 - 2. She must bring the family into her house: (Vs 19-20) Make sure no one leaves the "house of safety" Pictures separation/not returning to the world
 - 3. She must not betray them, but protect them: (Vs 20) (Picture of not deserting the LORD'S mission)
- B. The Seal of Her Salvation: (Vs 20-21) (James 2:21-26)
- 1. She demonstrated true faith did not betray her commitment: (Vs 20)
 - 2. She tied the rope in the window: (Vs 21)

V. Rahab's faith saved others: (Vs 22-24)

A. The Spies: (Vs 22-24)

Enabled the spies to escape & return to give their report

- 1. They heeded her advice: (Vs 22)
- 2. They returned to camp & reported to Joshua: (Vs 23)
- 3. The declaration of their own faith: (Vs 24)
 - The LORD has given the land into our hands
 - The people are panic-stricken
- B. Rehab's Family was Saved: (Joshua 6:22-23)
