<u>Date Written</u>: 760-750 BC During Reign of Jeroboam II of

Israel & Uzziah of Judah

The Social/Economic Times:

The wealthy of Israel were enjoying peace & prosperity. They were oppressing the poor, through Taxation. even selling them into slavery.

Soon, Israel would be conquered by Assyria,

& the rich would not escape being made slaves.

Key Verse: (Amos 5:24) "But let judgment run down as waters, and righteousness as a mighty stream."

 - a. Two calves of gold: (I Kings 12:28)
 - 1.) Same sin as in the wilderness: (Exo 32:4)
 - 2.) Now double trouble with the 2 calves.
 - b. Established calves in Bethel and Dan: (I Ki 12:29)
 - c. It was a sin. (I Kings 12:30)
 - d. False Teachers of our day: (2 Pet 2:1-6)
- B. Jeroboam II.
 - 1. 200 Years later.
 - 2. Amos Prophet.
 - 3. Judgment again pronounced.
