Title: Why do I Still Sin?

Text: (Romans 7:13-25)

“The Tension of the Unfinished Life”-(Phil 1:6) (1 Jn 1:8, 10)

You carry a deadly concealed weapon: (James 3:8b)

All our past, present, & future sin is under the blood of Jesus.

The closer we get to God, the more we see our own sin.

(Is 6:1-5)

Paul reflects sinful humility in other scriptures too.

(1Cor 15:9)(Eph.3:8)(1Tim.1:15)

I. A Saved Person Has A New Passion for Righteousness:

(Vs 15-21)

1. A SAVED person's WILL has been changed.

a. A saved person has had a change of heart, mind & desires.

b. He really WANTS to do what is right: (Lk 22:42)

c. A Sign of a supernatural transformation: (Ps 37:4).

d. A saved person has a heart that doesn't resist God.

e. A Refashioned "WILL"

f. A New Set of DESIRES.

2. A SAVED person's Desires have changed b/c A Christian has been given a brand new nature, and made into a brand new person from the inside out.

The Tension of an Unfinished Life: (Rom 6:1-7)

Salvation means we have a choice as to what we will do

(Rom 6:11-18)

Some believe that this One & Done thing: (2 Cor 5:17)

Then why do we have to put off the Old Man & Put On the New man daily? (Eph 4:22-24)

Yes, We are a New Creature, but the choice is still hours to Choose Right over Flesh. (2 Pet 1:3-4)(Phil 1:6)

He despised the things of God for he was on mission to persecute and destroy the church of God. (Phil 3:4-11)

When Christ confronted Paul: (Acts 9:4,6)

"for to will is present with me" (Rom 7:18)

"when I would do good" (Rom 7:21)

"For I delight in the law of God after the inward man:" (v.22)

“I want to Do Right in My Heart”

I. A Saved Person Has A New Passion for Righteousness:

1. *A SAVED person's WILL has been changed.*

2. *A SAVED person's desires have changed because his/her NATURE has been changed.*

Whats Wrong with you?

God's Not Done with you.

This is “The Tension of the Unfinished Life”.

(Phil 1:6) *Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ:*
