Title: God Speaks To Us

Text: (Heb 1:1-4; Heb 2:1)

1st Truth - God is the initiator in the Relationship

2nd Truth – God gives the Instructions

3rd Truth - God's Instructions are our Invitation to join in

4th Truth – God is more interested in "Being" than "Doing"

5th Truth – God Reveals Himself to us

6th Truth – God speaks to us

(Heb 1:1-4; Heb 2:1) *"Therefore... give the more earnest heed"*
(Acts 3:21, Lk 11:49)

They knew about the coming Saviour- (Job 19:25)

They knew of the Resurrection – (Job 19:26)

They knew about the destruction and renewal – (Acts 3:21)

(Jn 14:9-11) When Jesus Speaks, it is really from the Father!

(Jn 14:16-17; 26) He would send the Comforter to lead us.

(Jn 14:18-21) He does Speak to us: *"Manifest"*

(Jn 14:22-23) He promises to Reveal himself to us.

(Jn 14:24) - *"Loveth me not keepeth not my sayings"*

(Jn 14:25-26) *"Send in my name...All things to remembrance"*

(1 Cor 2:9-11) We cannot understand his book w/o His help.

(Heb 1:1-2)

(John 16:13) He sent the Holy Spirit to lead us into all truth

(Rom 16:25-26) God *"manifested"* Himself through the Word.

(John 15:5) *"for without me ye can do nothing."*

(Heb 1:2) *"Hath"* No more like it was in the OT.

(Rev 22:18) God is not adding to this book anymore.

(1 Cor 13:8-10) *"Perfect" is the written Word of God!*

1st Truth is that God speaks to His People

2nd God's message always points to Jesus! (Heb 1:2)

(Jn 6:45) *"Taught of God"* (Jn 15:26)

(Rev 1:1) *"The revelation of Jesus Christ!"*

3rd Truth – The Holy Spirit leads us back to this book

(Jn 17:17) Jesus proclaims God's Word to be the TRUTH!

(Jn 16:13-14) He will glorify Jesus!

When we let the Holy Spirit work in our lives...

1. The Spirit of Truth will work through this book of Truth, and lead us to the feet of Jesus! (Come to Jesus)

When we let the Holy Spirit work in our lives...

2. We will see Jesus on every page! (Talk about Jesus)

When we let the Holy Spirit work in our lives...

3. We will Glorify Jesus!

All of that was introduction....

(Jn 14:5-6) see Him saying this from Compassion

(2 Cor 5:14) *"for the love of Christ constraineth us, because we..*

(Heb 2:1) *"Therefore"* Because Jesus is the revelation of God!

God Speaks to us!

The message always points to Jesus.

He always expects a response!

God still speaks to us, and He expects a response!

2 questions to ask whenever we read the word, hear the preaching or teaching.

Jesus what are you saying to me?

Jesus what do you want me to do about it?

What ever the need, the answer of Jesus.

What ever the question the answer is found at the feet of Jesus.

What ever the hardship, the supply is from Jesus.
