(Matt 26:36-41) - <u>4 Groups of People At Gethsemane</u>

- *<u>Illus</u>*: 1. Those that make things happen.
 - 2. Those that watch things happen.
 - 3. Those that wonder what happened.
- Group 1: "I can, You can, Let's do it!
- Group 2: "I can, You Can't, get out of my way & let me do it.
- Group 3: "I can't, You can't either, whose crazy Idea was this anyway."
- (Matt 26:20-25) *"One of you will betray me."* At some point they all must have had their doubts about Jesus.
- (Jn 13:25-30) Jesus identifies who it was to John, but the rest didn't know who He spoke of.
- (Matt 26:36-39) The greatest travesty in human History is about to be perpetrated.

<u>4 Groups of People</u> in this Story

- **Group 4** Judas In the world Lost Has no use for God, His Word, or His People
- **Group 3** The 8 disciples Closer to Christ, but on the periphery. (Closest to the world)
- **Group 2** The Inner circle 3 disciples who were the closest.
- **Group 1** Christ who was alone, went the farthest.

I. <u>Notice their position to Christ:</u>

- Group 4 (Judas) In the World Most likely Lost (Jn 12:4-6; Matt 26:6-9)Mad/disappointed @ God.
- **Group 3** (8 Disciples) (Matt 26:36) The Majority of Christians today. Nearest the World, Farthest from Christ, but still in the garden.
- **Group 2** (Peter, James, & John) (Matt 26:37) Closest to Christ, farther from the world.
- Group 1 Christ) Furthest from the world, closest to God
 - II. Notice the difference in number
- **Group 4** (Multitude) (Mat 26:47)
- Group 3 (8 Disciples) Has the highest number of Christians in it They don't hate God. They are just 1 step away from the world!
- Group 2 (Peter, James, & John) Smaller in number.
 2 Steps from the world 1 Step closer to Christ In the middle – Still not where Christ is, but not leaning toward the World.
- **Group 1** (Christ) Smallest in number. Closest to the Father, Angels ministering.

III. Notice their Commitment

Group 1 (Vs 39) (Jesus) Not my will but thine"

Group 2 (Vs 40-41) Stopped Praying when they got tired Still Controlled by the Flesh

Group 3 (Vs 43) (8 Disciples) A sleep

Group 4 Christian by Tradition: (Matt 26:14-16) Christian in Name Only: Christmas & Easter Committed to themselves

IV. <u>Notice their Service</u>

Group 4 (Luke 13:26-27) (2 Cor 11:13,15) Everybody knows Group 4 is lost, irregardless of what they say, their actions prove it! (Matt 7:17-18)

Group 3 He didn't tell them to do anything, WHY? Because He can't count on them to do anything. These 8 Powerless Disciples. 1 step from the world. Always looking for a better offer in the Flesh. Will serve when it benefits them to do so. <u>Illus</u>: Group 3 Christians cause more damage to the cause of Christ, because they shake the faith of others

We see this in (Mk 9:17-24) (*22) "If thou Canst?" what a reproach to the son of God.

- This kind of Faithless Christianity has done more to hurt the cause of Christ than all of the harlots, drunkards, and drug addicts combined.
- (Matt 24:48-51) God calls these Nominal Christians EVIL and HYPOCRITS

Group 2	(MT 26:38,40-41) Quits when it stops being fun
Group 1	(Matt 26:51-54) Follows through to God's Will.

So Which Group are you in?

Not my will but Thine? Anything you want God, just say the Word!

Can God get that kind of a response from you?

Not My will but THINE, ... IF THINE lines up with MINE, then were FINE!

Not my will but THINE, If THINE lines up with MINE, then MINE is THINE & THINE is MINE were really fine!

When you can say, "*Not my will but Thine*" Then God truly is your master! Then Gods truly is your Lord.

What are we afraid of? <u>Illus</u>: God might send me to Africa.

I Have found that I am happiest in God's will rather than mine!

I would rather be out of the ministry, In God's will than in the ministry, Out of God's Will!
