b. Sun and moon will be marvelously transformed.

(vs 31)(Acts 2:20)

c. Nature will be welcoming her Sovereign

2. Basis of Deliverance. (vs 32) CR: (Rom 10:13)

a. Whosoever calls in repentance & faith.
