Faith is not rooted in human wisdom.

Faith is rooted the word of God.

II. The requirement of Abraham's faith.

Obedience - Action

If you know these things happy are ye if you do them.

The root of faith was revelation.
The requirement of Faith - was separation.

The Root of faith - Revelation (God's Word): The Requirement of faith - Separation (Obedience);

III. The Reward of faith - appropriation.
