Purpose of the Parent vs. the Purpose of the Pastor

Influence by Orders of Magnitude:

The Youth Pastor is a tool in your hand to support your preaching/training efforts.
He is not a replacement of you.

Parenting is a Solemn Trust:
Children are a Gift from God: You Received that Child from God. (Psalm 127:3)

Children are only on Loan from God: We are to Enlist them for God's Service.

(Ephesians 6:4) Educate & Cultivate

PARENTS DUTY TO THEIR CHILDREN IS: To Enjoy/Esteem them in Love. (Titus 2:4)

To Escort/Lead Them to Christ. (Matthew 19:14)

To Exercise/Train Them Up for God. (Prov 22:6)

To Expound God's Word. (Deut 11:19) (Isaiah 38:19)

To Educate them of God's Judgments: (Joel 1:3)

None of that is the job of the Pastor or Youth Pastor.

Explain The Role of The Pastor: (Mal 4:6)

He is a helper, or feeder of the sheep

(Jer 2:8; 3:15; 10:21; 12:10; 17:16; Eph 4:11)

(Eph 4:11-16) And he (God) gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; (WHY?)

12 For the perfecting (to bring to completion; to finisher make flawless/faultless)

#1 12 For the perfecting of the saints,

#2 for the work of the ministry,

#3 for the edifying of the body of Christ:

(Duration of Effort) 13 Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ: (Till Jesus Comes, or I Die)

14 That (For the Desired Result of)

#1 we henceforth be no more children, (Immature) (We are not trying to raise Godly Children, We are trying to help you raise up successive Generations of Christlike adults that serve God)

Children are easily Led astray:

NOT tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive; (Led astray by Deceivers to false Doctrine through Ignorance or Fleshly Lusts)

15 But (In Contrast)

#2 speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ: 16 From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love.

(As the Body of Christ, We are a Doctrinally Correct, Morally Strong, Compassionate, body of Believers that Live & Serve in Love, Unity; Valuing All People)

Explain Influence:

Your children's Opinion of Truth is an average between all the voices they listen too.
The Pastor & Youth Pastor is to be another set of voices saying the same things as the Parents.
