## **A Spiritual Self Evaluation:**

The Challenge from Solomon is Self-Evaluation

(Proverbs 1:22) (Simple, Scorner, Fool) How long... ye simple ones, will ye love simplicity? How long... will ye scorners delight in their scorning, How long... will ye fools hate knowledge?

Simple Person: (Vs 22) Does not mean a mental handicap. Simple means. Literally~ Having space.

<u>In other words, they have not made up there mind yet.</u> They have no firm convictions. Open to any influence equally. Easily Allured or Deceived.

Simple is the opposite of Prudent.

Scorner: (Vs 22) They delight in their scorner. The scorner is resisting revealed truth. The scorner likes to bring reproach upon authority. He hears what God says but resists it. A True Critic. The scorner is dangerous b/c they influence others. Casting them out is our only option. (Prov 22:10) What if we went OT on them, & stone them to death?

**Fool**=Rejects the Word of God. (Ps 14:1) *The fool hath said in his heart there is no God.* Do We say no to God?

## Fools are determined in going their way.

(Prov 12:15) *The way of a fool is right in his own eyes: but he that hearkeneth unto counsel is wise.* 

He/She has all the Answers.

He/She needs no one else's counsel.

He/She doesn't care what others think about him/her. He/She is apathetic @ what God thinks about him/her. He/She is Unwilling to learn.

Illus: Experience is the best teacher.

Even then won't admit they are wrong. lays blame on others.

You can't help a fool. (Prov 14:7)

## Wise Man: (Proverbs 1:5)

A wise man will hear, and will increase learning; and a man of understanding shall attain unto wise counsels: They are Responding to the Word of God.

Hear Learning: Receive it Increase Learning: Take it to heart Attain: Seek after *Is This You & I*?
