## **Persistence in Prayer**

Text: (Dan 9:1-4)

## **Old Timers called it -** *Praying Through = Persistence*

Sinners don't have to pray through to be saved: Salvation is instantaneous, not a process! Jn 3:36 "Hath" Has NOW!

## Bible Proof of Instant Salvation:

Jn 1:12 Jn 3:3, 9-12 Picture of a birth. You are not born till you are all the way out! Jn 3:16,18 Belief is a choice. <u>Illus</u>: Can't be partially Pregnant! Jn 5:24 Jn 6:47 Rom 10:13

Instant Salvation Examples:

Lk 18:13-14 Publical Praying in the temple Lk 23:42-43 Thief on the Cross Acts 16:14-15 Lydia's Testimony Acts 16:32-34 Philippian Jailor

Reasons why Christians are to Pray Through: Persistent, believing, intercessory, agonizing prayer is proper for a Christian when he takes his burdens to God. Examples: Gen 22:24-29 Jacob Wrestling with God Dan 9:3-4 Dan 10:2- He prayed and fasted 3 weeks Neh 1:4 Prayed and fasted "Certain Days Acts 9:9,11 Paul Prayed and fasted for 3 days Lk 11:5-8 "Importunity" Lk 18:1-8 Parable of the unjust Jusdge

**Fasting and Prayer:** Lk :34-35; Mark 9: 28-29 What is Fasting and Prayer: - *Putting God First*. There is times we ought to eat and Praise God. Ps103:2,5 There is times when sleep is the will of God. Ps 127:2; Ps 3:5 Every good gift is given og God and meant to be enjoyed. Jam 1:17

**Fasting**: To earnestly seek the face God, (Thus Prayer), and for a time put off *Lesser Blessings* in order to receive the *Greater One*. Putting God first when we pray, wanting it more than food, drink, etc.

<u>Illus</u>: There are many occaisions when we obstain from certain food or drink, Football training, Medical tests, etc. None of which involves prayer.

**Fasting means Persistence in Prayer:** We all pray often, but not much! LK 18:3 *"Continual Coming"* 

**<u>Fasting</u>** is the deliberate clearing of the way for prayer, laying aside weights and hindrances. Heb 12:1-2, Matt13:22 *Choke the Word* 

**Fasting** ought to be simply claiming the answer to prayers. Heb 11:6 fasting pictures a greater desire, determination, and faith.

**Fasting** is an expression of Mourning. David- 2 Sam 12:16,21 mourning for the afflicted child. Samuel- 1 Sam 15:11 Mourning over Saul's Rejection.

Things we get by Fasting and Prayer:

- 1. Help in times of trouble: Ps 50:15; Judges 20:26
- 2. Find what is displeasing to God. Josh 7:6 "Until Eventide".
- 3. Genuine Repentance can involve P & F Zech 12:10-14 Jam 4:9
- 4. Victory over Sin:
- 5. Heavenly wisdom received from P & F: Acts 13:1-3
- 6. Intercession for Others:
