<u>Title: How Do I Praise God in a Time Like This?</u>

What is Praise?

The word comes from the Latin pretium, "price," or "value," Def~ ascription of value or worth. Adoration of God, (Re 4:11) (Rev 5:12).

In the Bible; God is the object of praise.

The whole creation praises Him, Angels of heaven (Ps 103:20; Re 5:11) The unconscious/inanimate (Ps 19:1-4; 148:1-10; Re 5:13).

Praise is expression of gratitude for personal favors conferred; (Psalms 40:3)

Praise is To commend; to applaud; to express in words or song; to magnify; to glorify on account of perfections or excellent works. (Ps 47:6-7) (Ps 148:1)

Praise is To show honor to the excellence of God's Works

(Psa 145:10) All thy works shall praise thee, O Lord.

Our praise becomes a blessing & thanksgiving to God. (Ps 34:1-22) God hears (Ps 103:1-22) Redemption and forgiveness (Eph 1:3) Spiritual Blessings (1Pe 1:3) Salvation

Fruit of the lips. (Hebrews 13:15) Voice of praise. (Psalm 66:8) Voice of triumph. (Psalm 47:1) Voice of melody. (Isaiah 51:3) Voice of a psalm. (Psalm 98:5) **Garment of praise.** (Isaiah 61:3) **Sacrifice of praise.** (Hebrews 13:15) **Sacrifices of joy.** (Psalm 27:6)

It is our Duty to Praise God:

Not Praising God withholds from God, (Ps 50:23; Ro 1:20) Not Praising God shut one's eyes to His presence (Isa 40:26) Not Praising God to be forgetful of His mercies (De 6:12) Not Praising God is to be unthankful for His kindness (Lk 6:35).

We must earnestly cultivate the spirit and habit of praise.

Who He is: He Is Worthy: (Rev 4:11)

What He has done: (Ps 42:-4) (2Co 9:15) We need to take His Blessing Personally: (Ps 66:16)

What He promised He would do:

How Do I Praise God in a Time Like This? By Focussing our thoughts on God who allowed these circumstances:

Give your Soul a Wake Up Call: (Ps 57:8; 103:1), Fixing Your heart upon God: (Ps 57:7; 108:1) Meditation on His works and ways: (Ps 77:11) Take Inventory of His benefits: (Ps 103:2) Meditate His unspeakable gift: (2Co 9:15) (1Jo 3:1)

How Do I Praise God in a Time Like This? By Letting our thoughts of God express themselves in Song:

<u>Talk to yourself using other peoples Music</u>: (Eph 5:19) Christian Radio, Heart Radio, Apple Music, Google, etc <u>2nd greatest book in your Home is the Hymnal</u>: (Col 3:16) The Book of Psalms is the proof of this for the Old Testament.

True praise of God, is first of all an inward emotion:

A gladness & rejoicing of the heart: (Ps 4:7) (Ps 33:21)

When God fills the heart with praise He puts a new song into the mouth: (Ps 40:3)

A music of the soul & spirit: (Ps 103:1) (Lu 1:46)

Which no language can adequately express: SO SING IT! (Ps 105:2)

Even when under Affliction:

(Acts 16:25) Paul and Silas Prayed and Sang Hymns of Praise

How Do I Praise God in a Time Like This?

By Letting our thoughts of God express themselves in Verbal Prayer: (Col 1:3) Our mouth instinctively strives to express the praises of our heart. (Ps 51:15)

Then let the revelation of your heart find expression through your lips giving PRAISE!
