I. Introduction:

- A. Ready for God's final judgments: (Is 13:11,13)
- B. Two coming events which overshadow all others
 - 1. The Rapture of God's people: (1 Thess 4:16-17)
 - 2. The Return of God with His people: (Rev 19:11-14)
 - 3. 3 series of 7 Judgments Fall on Mankind. (Jn 5:24)
- C. Each 7 fold series divided between first 4 & last 3.
- 1. First four trumpets are woes upon nature
- 2. Last three trumpets directed toward mankind

II. Silence in heaven: (Rev 8:1)

- A. "He" that is the Lamb, Jesus
- B. "Silence" unusual for heaven to be silent
 - 1. First 4 Seals: voice like thunder: "Come & See"
 - 2. 5th Seal: Cry from Beneath the Altar.
 - 3. 6th Seal: Fearful Tremor
 - 4. 7th Seal: (Rev 4) The 4 Cherubims:
- C. What kind of silence is this? (Heb 12:1)
 - 1. Intense Expectancy: (Acts 22:2)
 - 2. Agasp Awe & Ominous foreboding: (Rev 8:1)

III. The Seven Angels of the Divine Presence: (Rev 8:2)

A. Seven distinct Angels of glory:

- 1. There are orders and ranks of angelic hosts (Eph 3:10) *Principalities & Powers*. (Luke 1:19) "Stand in the Presence of God"
- 2. These 7 personally minister to God the Father!

B. They are given Seven Trumpets

- 1. <u>Horns</u>: portrays the life of the people.
- 2. 7 trumpets are signal the judgments:

- 2. He stands at the altar of sacrifice an "angel-priest"

V. The 1st Trumpet: (Rev 8:6-7) Land, Trees, Grass

- A. "as it were" (Rev 8:8, 10)
- B. Literal: (Ex 9:23-24) (Rom 1:25)
- C. 11 times the number "1/3" is used in this chapter.

VI. <u>The 2nd Trumpet</u>: (Rev 8:8-9) Sea Creatures, Commerce

(Vs 6-7) Wealth from Real-Estate, Crops, Livestock

(Vs 8-9) Wealth from International Commerce Destroyed.

VII. The 3rd Trumpet: (Rev 8:10-11) Fresh Water

- A. An Asteroid/Comet
- B. "Wormwood" = Absinthe bitter, poisonous herb.

VIII. <u>The Fourth Trumpet</u>: (Rev 8:12) Heavenly Bodies: Sun, Moon, Stars: (Ex 10:21-23)

- A. Angel of judgment: (Deut 28, Jer 28, Matt 24:28)
- B. Execution & Judgment may: (2 Kings 9:30-37)
- C. God always gives a warning: (Ezekiel 33:11)
