Through Christ-honoring music

Through Biblically-sound preaching

Through the Praise and Testimony of It's members

### You have to Be Proactive!

Fellowship starts with you.

Everyone who comes is an opportunity for you to be a blessing!

# Look for someone to be friendly to. YOU SHOULD NEVER SIT!

You be the first to offer everyone the right hand of Christian fellowship!

They are not on familiar ground. YOU ARE!

Distracts attention from the Holy Ghost.

<u>Leave Right!</u> Leave planning to return at the next service. Heb 10:24-25 - 3 to Thrive

To *Include* them in a loving church family (Acts 2:41) Develop a strategic biblical follow up program.

Visit, build relationships, and connect the visitors to people in the church of like age and station in life through fellowships and activities.

Develop the effective use of technology and tools to equip the church to function, teach, and communicate with its members and visitors.

For example, only people 55 and over read the local news paper, TV, and almost no one uses the Yellow pages anymore.

Teens receive all their information through their phone. 30-55 year olds get their information from a computer screen.

## 1. A Proper Applicant: Believer, not Babies

<u>Illus</u>: Scriptural Baptism is Believer's Baptism

Matt 28:19 – "Teaching them the Gospel" came 1st.

Acts 2:38, 41 Repentance and receiving the Word came 1st.

Acts 8:12 After responding to preaching.

Acts 8:35-38 His profession came 1st Rom 10:9-10

*<u>Illus</u>*: Babies cannot be scripturally be baptized!

This doctrine is build upon the presupposition that when the bible said an entire household was baptized, assuming there were infants in the household at that time.

<u>Illus</u>: I have a dog in my household, does that mean she should be a candidate too?

### 2. A Proper Action- Immersion

"Baptidzo" Immerse, Plunge, Dip, Cover"

"In Jordan" – Matt 3:6; Mark 1:5

"Into the Water" Acts 8:38

"Out of the Water" Matt 3:6; Acts 8:39

## Baptism is a Burial – Rom 6:4; Col 2:12

## 3. A Proper Aim- Symbol Only

Baptism does not wash away original Sin.
It is not a part of Salvation.
It is the Gospel in Picture Form: Death, Burial, Ressurection
Rom 6:4,5,17; 1 Pet 3:21

**Proper Motive** is OBEY Christ Command, IDENTIFY with Christ Publically, and PROCLAIM the Gospel in Symbolic form.

**4.** <u>A Proper Administrator</u> – Who has the right to Baptize? Churches or Christians?

Ilus: If it didn't matter, why did Jesus walk 60 miles to John? Matt 21:23-27; Mark 11:28-33; Lk 20:1-6 By what authority doest... John 1:6 John was sent by God Vs 29-31 "therefore am I come baptizing with water"

Who did Jesus give the great Commission to?

Matt 28:19 The Apostles

Acts 1:4,6,8 The Apostles

John 20:19,21 "So Send I You"

1 Cor 12:28 – The Apostles were the 1st church!

Act 13:1-3 sent out

Acts 2:41, 1 Cor 12:13 Baptizes you unto the Church!

**The Necessity of the Ordinance** – So why get Baptized if it causes so much of a fuss?

**To the Individual-** Baptism is not Optional <u>It's a Command</u> – Matt 28:19 <u>Illus</u>: If Christ commanded the church to Baptize, then every Christian is to be Baptized! Acts 2:38 "Be Baptized everyone of you" John 14:15 Obedience is an act of Love!

<u>It Follows Christ's Example</u> – Matt 3:16 Jesus' was baptized Lk 3:21b God said He was "Well Pleased"

<u>It places the believer into the Church</u>- Acts 2:41, 1 Cor 12:13

It Associates the believer publicly with the Death and Resurrection of Christ – **Identification** Rom 6:3-5; Gal 3:27, Col 2:12

Are you ashamed to be identified with Christ? Lk 9:26; Matt 10:32-33 Baptism is confessing Christ Publically.

**To the Church**-Baptism is the Door to the Church-Acts 2:41 **Protects the church**-

From unregenerate Membership
From Heretical teachers; Identify with Church
Doctrine

From Ungodly living- Rom 6:1-3 Seeing it practiced by new believers reminds others to Live Godly.

# Are You Saved? Have you been baptized like this? ALL 4 Must be Accomplished to be Valid.

Acts 2:41 Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls.

Baptism-Adds them to the church, but they are long way from feeling included!

Heb 10: 24-25

#### **Consider:**

You have to think about it!

Church is not a place where you only Get.

This Isn't About You!

It is a place where you give of yourself!

Heb 10:25a - Show up! Illus: Who is it that doesn't want you to go to church? Is that feeling from God? NO!

- I. Who wins if you don't! Whose kingdom is benefited?
- II. **Show UP! Jn 20:24-25** Thomas missed Jesus and the Blessing **Vs 22** *He breathed on them!*
- III. Eph 2:20-22 The building of God is incomplete with out you there! You discourage everyone when you miss!
- IV. **Ps 63:1** Come hungry-excited, and expecting!
- V. **Arrive Early: Pr 8:17,** Jesus Showed up early Jn 8:1-2 The Apostles showed up early Acts 5:19-21,

#### **Mentoring Others:** 2 Tim 2:2

Take time to lead others to a closer walk with the Lord.

To *Instruct* them in Bible doctrines (II Tim 2:2) Connect God's Word personally and practically too every age group.

Develop a multifaceted outreach that generates a regular stream of guests from all ages and backgrounds.

Through weekly soulwinning

Through a worldwide missions program

Through training and equipping Christians to share Christ in the course of their daily lives.
