  The passage parallels Revelation 19:11-21.

## e. God's Retrobution vs 8, 9

It is no wonder it is called the "great day of his wrath" (Revelation 6:17).

# 1.) Flaming fire.

- a.) Fire is often associated with the Divine presence in the OT (Ex 3:2) (Isa 66:15)
  - b.) God will come in fiery vengeance.
  - c.) God is a consuming fire. (Heb 12:29) For our God is a consuming fire.
- 2.) Today, the world as a whole does not want to consider the fact that God is going to execute vengeance upon it. (2 Pet 3:3-7)
- a.) Men of "religion" assure their hearers that a God of love would not seek to punish anyone.
- b.) Only God alone has the right to Punish His creation. (Deut 32:35) *To me belongeth vengeance, & recompence;*
- c.) People today lack the character to execute judgment themselves upon the wicked, and therefore they do not expect God to do so either.
  - d.) Vengeance belongs to God. (Heb 10:30-31)
  - e.) Love is NOT incompatible with vengeance: (Ps 7:11)

## 3.) Man's sin.

- a.) They do not know God: (Rom 1:28)
- b.) They do not obey the Gospel.
  - (1) They obey not the truth: (Rom 2:8)
  - (2) They have heard the Word and rejected it.

# 4.) Man's punishment.

- a.) Eternal destruction to the wicked.
  - (1) Hell often relegated to folklore & myth.
- (2) Many people who believe in heaven don't want to believe in hell.
  - (3) Ridicule does not mean Hell doesn't exist.
  - (4) Hell is more than a place of physical torment.
  - (5) Essence of eternal life is to be with God, To be without Him is eternal death.
  - b.) The Damned are Shut out of the presence of the Lord.
    - (1) Deprived of the blessing of God's presence.
    - (2) Endless separation from the presence of God. (Lam 4:16)(Heb 8:9b)
    - (3) Pass into a night on which no morning dawns.
    - (4) Final horror of sin isseparation from God. (Isa 59:2)
  - c.) Removal from glory and power.
    - (1) They are fit for the penalty they will receive.
    - (2) They are without excuse. (Rom 1:20)
    - (3) Their punishment is not vindictive but deserved. (Rev 19:15) (Is 11:4)

#### f. Glorification of Christ. vs 10

1.) Glorified in them: (I John 3:2)

#### 2.) Admired in them.

- a.) Relationship of the saints to the blessed hope.
- b.) 2nd Coming of Christ justifies the Believer.

(Matt 24:30; Lk 21:27)

### B. God's Desire for them. vs 11, 12

- 1. Worthiness was sought. vs 11, (Eph 4:1)
  - a. Because we are called.
  - b. Because we obey.

#### 2. God's Fullness was to be seen. vs 11

- a. In doing God's will.
- b. In doing God's work.
  - 1.) Faith needs growth to remain active and alive.
  - 2.) Power of God must operate in men's lives (vs 11)

# 3. God's Purpose shown in them. vs 12

- a. Name of Christ glorified.
- b. Our lives are to glorify Jesus Christ: (Phil 1:20)
- c. All because of God's grace.
