Why would Jesus ask this Question?

(Mark 12:28-34) They ask about the Great Commandment.

This is the #1 question to Go to Heaven

World's general consensus is that Jesus was just a man

This is the critical issue.

<u>BUT</u> if the Bible is true - and it is - Jesus is God and Man,

THEN what He says is true,

To reject Christianity & deny its truthfulness,

You have to reject the deity of Jesus Christ.

A Key Question for every Individual of every Generation

As Eternal God: The Messiah is David's Lord.

As Man: He is David's Son/Descendant.

Why didn't the Jewish Leadership Believe?

(Jn 12:37-46)

Jesus sends them into a Theological Panic

Ps 110 was accepted by all Jews as Messianic.

Jesus warned the People: (Matt 23:13-36)

Peter Warned us Also: (2 Pet 2:1-10)

<u>Jesus Confronts Error with Condemnation, Not a Conversation</u>. (Luke 20:46-47)

A Tale of Two Tragedies:

#1. <u>Tragedy</u>: They were destroying souls: (Matt 23:15) **#2.** <u>Tragedy</u>: There Hard Hearts made them reject Him
